Good News! Six people have recently joined our church.

The topic at the **Revitalization Cohort** meeting I attended was having a *Gospel-Centered* church. This is critical for a healthy revitalization. One of FBC's four core values is that we are Christ-centered, meaning everything we do should glorify Him.

But how is that different from being a Gospel Centered church? I was very surprised when several of the pastors there revealed that when they were young, joining the church was considered the same thing as being saved. And salvation was the same as joining a church. Wow! They have a very different understanding now.

One pastor told when he responding to the Pastor's invitation to come up at the end of the message for salvation. He did and he prayed for the Lord to forgive him and come into his heart. But the church announced only that he joined the church that day. Wow, again.

I hope all of us know the difference.

For our church to return to health and growth, we must all know the Gospel and how to communicate it.

It is not hard, long, or complicated. Read this and time yourself: "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures" (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)." There you go. Just say that.

Here's a thought. Complete this sentence: "For our church to become biblically heathy and Gospel-centered, we must..."

God tells us through Jude, "And you must show mercy to those whose faith is wavering. Rescue (save) others by snatching them from the flames of judgment. Show mercy to still others, but do so with great caution, hating the sins that contaminate their lives (1:22-23, NLT)." Rescuing or saving the lost can begin by praying for them by name. A tool that we use at

the Wednesday night prayer meeting is **Bless Every Home**. To be a part of this powerful prayer plan, scan the QR Code and follow the instructions.
