

Last week our Fellowship Team hosted a First Responders Appreciation lunch. Last year was the first time we entered a float in the Christmas parade. As you know, November 5 is election day. Most of us cannot remember our country being so divided and angry as we vote for leaders of our United States. It is not the church's place to ever say who to vote for. I will not. However, I will preach about voting on Nov 3. Read Romans 13:1-5 and 1 Timothy 2:1-6 to prepare your heart. Having read those passages, thank the Lord that we live in a land where we elect our governing authorities, unlike countries where kings or dictators rule without the people's voice on who gets to rule. That privilege and responsibility is worth our prayer and participation, not our neglect or refusal.

One of the things we have heard far more than the four previous elections is how one party hates the other party's candidate. Or how one party has all the right answers and the other is all wrong. Our challenge as true followers of Jesus Christ is to rise above individual politicians or their parties. This Sunday you might hear a new way to consider electing our nation's leaders that supersedes who you like or don't like.

Above all else, continue to pray.

As you continue to pray for our church, please include praying for the finances. The Lord has been gracious to us by providing our financial needs. At the same time, our weekly offerings are trending to be less than our budget requires.
